<u>Dues</u> - Annual Midwest Dues are \$3.00 per flyer. Members must be AU members to be included in the results. A list of members names, and number of birds shipped should be sent with dues or filled out on the Race Entry Recap sheet the night of shipping. Dues, sectional secretary fees and diploma/plaques can be paid the night of shipping.

<u>Transportation</u> - It is the responsibility of members and clubs to get their birds to the race station. Advise your drivers and liberators to report to our Midwest Liberator Mark Zima 1-920-810-8690 when arriving at the Topeka Expocenter. He will be driving the white and blue Wisconsin pigeon truck. <u>Liberation should be about 6:15 to 6:30 weather permitting.</u>

<u>Lodging</u> - Drivers can make reservations at the Hotel Topeka At City Center 1717 SW Topeka Boulevard Topeka Kansas. 1-785-431-7200. Hotel is on the same grounds as the Expco. Google Hotel Topeka at City Center for reservations.

Release & Liberation - No mandatory release. In case of inclement weather the liberation will be handled by the Wisconsin race Secretary, Illinois secretary, Minnesota liberator. Each club, combine, concourse, federation can decide to release or hold their birds. Liberation time and information will be posted on our website, www.MIDWESTHPA.com.

<u>QPS - Ewinspeed</u> It was voted and approved to use GPS exclusively since 2007. Use the following GPS coordinates for Topeka KS. Latitude 39:01.9433N Longitude 95:41.0617 We will again use **Ewinspeed** to figure overall and section results. We are set up as an Open Race through the AU. Your club results will appear in the overall race report as long as the date, liberation time and GPS match the Open Race.

Race Recap Sheets - Must be completely filled out showing member's name and number of birds and mailed by your secretary priority mail **ASAP after shipping (Basketing) Must be postmarked before birds are released.** Enclose check with all Midwest dues and fees from the top of the entry recap form. **Information sheet and recap forms can be downloaded from the Midwest website.** www.MIDWESTHPA.com.

<u>Time</u> - Set your master timer or electronic clock to central daylight time just prior to start and final knock off.

You can go the AU or Midwest website and the digital clock will pop up with exact universal time. You can also use www.time.gov.

Per AU rules: All birds liberated at Topeka KS with the Midwest Race Birds count in the Ewinspeed Open Race Results. No birds or lofts may be eliminated from the Open results. No counterfeit bands allowed.
